What is God?
God is a Spirit,
in and of himself infinite in being,
glory, blessedness, and perfection;
all-sufficient, eternal,
unchangeable, incomprehensible,
everywhere present, almighty;
knowing all things,
most wise, most holy, most just,
most merciful and gracious,
long-suffering,
and abundant in goodness and truth.

Are there more Gods than one? There is but one only, the living and true God.

How many persons are there in the Godhead? There are three persons in the Godhead: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one true, eternal God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory.


The Life of the Church
